The 2009 growing season began with persistent Spring rainfall and cool temperatures. Heat in the Summer led to good sugar development. Perfect ripening cycles in August and September, made for a great harvest on September 25th.

8 Months, 100% French Oak, 50% New

Tasting Notes

Lovely citrus and pineapple on the nose, with a crème brûlée note. The palate is rich and full, with opulent texture and solidly packed fruit. Apple custard and peach-pineapple flavors swirl around, lengthening the finish.
